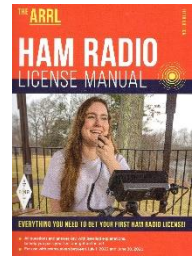


Interested in getting your Amateur (Ham) Radio License?

A new Technician class is planned and scheduled to help you pass the exam and get your license.

Where and When: At the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints on High School road (49967 Rd 427) in Oakhurst over 2 Saturdays; **February 25** and **March 4**. Both days will start at 8:00 A.M. and will last for about 6 hours. Those attending should bring their own lunch as there will be about a 30-minute break for lunch along with other short breaks during the day. There is no cost for the class, just bring pencil and paper for notes along with the study book if you purchased one.

Study Book; It is not required but the ARRL Technician Ham Radio License Manual, fifth edition, (valid from July 2022 through June 2026) will be used during the class. This book includes all exam questions with answers. Available from www.arrl.org and Amazon.



Preparation for exam day:

- Every candidate **MUST** register with the FCC CORES System and get an FCC Reference Number (FRN) before exam day. Use this link to get to the login/register page; <https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do>
- Every candidate must have a valid email address
